

2008/2013 ENVIRONMENT LEVY SPECIAL RATE VARIATION

The current environment levy program ends on 30 June 2008 and Council is seeking approval from the Minister for Local Government for a continuation of the levy. If a continuation is approved, Council proposes to undertake further works to maintain existing environmental projects that are rehabilitating creeks and wetlands, achieve urban environmental improvements, support Bushcare and Landcare work and conserve the Shire's biodiversity.

Further details are outlined in the Draft Plan of Management which is available for inspection at the Civic Centre, Moss Vale and at the Bowral, Mittagong and Moss Vale Libraries or on Council's website.
